Mrs. NORTON submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
3 the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union
4 for the consideration of S. 2475, an Act to provide for the
5 establishment of fair labor standards in employments in and
6 affecting interstate commerce, and for other purposes. That
7 after general debate, which shall be confined to the bill and
8 continue not to exceed four hours, to be equally divided
9 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority mem-
10 ber of the Committee on Labor, the bill shall be read for
11 amendment under the five-minute rule. At the conclusion
12 of the reading of the bill for amendment the Committee

1 shall rise and report the same to the House with such amend-
2 ments as may have been adopted, and the previous question
3 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
4 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
5 one motion to recommit, with or without instructions.
