RESOLUTION

- 1 Resolved, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
- 3 the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the
- 4 Union for the consideration of S. 2475, an Act to provide
- 5 for the establishment of fair labor standards in employments
- 6 in and affecting interstate commerce, and for other purposes,
- 7 and all points of order against said bill are hereby waived.
- 8 That after general debate, which shall be confined to the
- 9 bill and continue not to exceed four hours, to be equally
- 10 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
- 11 member of the Committee on Labor, the bill shall be read
- 12 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in

order to consider without the intervention of any point of 1 order the substitute amendment recommended by the Com-2 mittee on Labor, and such substitute for the purpose of 3 amendment shall be considered under the five-minute rule 4 5 as an original bill. At the conclusion of such consideration the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House 6 7 with such amendments as may have been adopted, and the previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill 8 and the amendments thereto to final passage without inter-9 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or without 10 instructions.
