Mrs. NORTON submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
3 the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the
4 Union for the consideration of S. 2475, an Act to provide
5 for the establishment of fair labor standards in employments
6 in and affecting interstate commerce, and for other purposes,
7 and all points of order against said bill are hereby waived.
8 That after general debate, which shall be confined to the
9 bill and continue not to exceed four hours, to be equally
10 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
11 member of the Committee on Labor, the bill shall be read
12 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in

1 order to consider without the intervention of any point of
2 order the substitute amendment recommended by the Com-
3 mittee on Labor, and such substitute for the purpose of
4 amendment shall be considered under the five-minute rule
5 as an original bill. At the conclusion of such consideration
6 the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House
7 with such amendments as may have been adopted, and the
8 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
9 and the amendments thereto to final passage without inter-
10 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or without
11 instructions.
