AMENDMENTS

Intended to be proposed by Mr. LODGE to the bill (S. 2475) to provide for the establishment of fair labor standards in employments in and affecting interstate commerce, and for other purposes, viz:

On page 53, lines 24 and 25, strike out "in any State;".
On page 54, line 5, strike out the comma and the words
"in any State".

4 On page 66, between lines 12 and 13, insert the follow-5 ing new subsection:

6 "(e) The United States Tariff Commission is author-7 ized and directed (1) to compute for each foreign country 8 the average annual volume of each class of goods which 9 were produced, manufactured, mined, handled, or in any

other manner worked on in such country and which were 1 imported into the United States during the five-year period $\mathbf{2}$ immediately preceding the date of enactment of this Act. and 3 (2) to certify to the Secretary of the Treasury the computa-4 tions so made. Thereafter no goods of any class shall be 5 allowed to be imported into the United States from any 6 7 foreign country during any calendar year in excess of the average annual volume of that class of goods so computed and 8 certified by the Commission unless it is shown to the satis-9 10 faction of the Labor Standards Board that the labor standards in such country which are applicable to the class of goods 11 12 to which such computation applies are at least equal to the labor standards under which like or similar goods of that 13 class are produced in the United States. The Commission 14 and the Secretary of the Treasury are authorized, respec-15 tively, to make such rules and regulations as may be neces-16 sary to carry out the provisions of this subsection, and the 17 various agencies of the Government are authorized and 18 directed to cooperate to the fullest practicable extent with 19 20the Commission and the Secretary of the Treasury in carrying out their functions under this subsection." 21
