SUBJECT: The Index to Legal Memoranda, and
The Index to Briefs

There are being sent to you one copy each of the recently mimeographed Index to Legal Memoranda and the Index to Briefs prepared by the Office of the Solicitor, for the use of the attorneys of the Wage and Hour Division. These indexes are for the confidential and official use of the attorneys of the Wage and Hour Division only. This material was prepared for use in Wage and Hour cases only.

The latter part of each index contains a numerical listing of the legal memoranda and the briefs in chronological order. These listings should be consulted, after the index has been used, in order to obtain a complete picture of the information that each particular memoranda or brief contains.

Any request for a copy of a particular memoranda or brief should be made by referring to its "LM" or "B" number.

The Index to the Legal Memoranda should not be confused with the Litigation Manual Memoranda. The "LM" number appearing at the end of each index is a clerical reference only, and has no relationship to numbers that have been given to Litigation Manual Memoranda.

In most cases there are no extra copies available of any briefs. Attorneys in the field who may request such briefs will be furnished with a summary of the brief by a member of the Washington staff. The situation with respect to the memoranda is somewhat better and, if it is possible, a copy of the memorandum requested will be sent to the inquirer.
