As a result of an anonymous tip a reinspection of the subject company was begun on June 23, 1941. This inspection disclosed no evidence which in the opinion of Legal justified reopening the case.

On September 19, 1941, Mr. Koetteritz suggested reinspection in the near future. Since that date several letters have been received from competitors stating that they believe the company to be still violating. However, no complaints have been received from employees.

I discussed reinspection with Mr. Koetteritz in September 1942 and it was agreed that no inspection of the firm will be made at this time. The file is therefore returned to be placed in the closed files.
