Wage determinations issued under the Service Contract Act  
covering contracts for <sup>DEPT</sup> mail hauling services

This is in reply to your letter of February 27, 1970, concerning the application of the subject wage determinations to contracts on which contractors use vehicles such as sedans, station wagons, Chevrolet Suburbans and Sportvans, hearses, or ambulances.

Wage determinations for over-the-road hauling of mail and those for short-run hauling of goods and merchandise which would include mail are not applicable to contracts where passenger cars (including conventional type station wagons) are used. Chevrolet Suburbans and Sportvans and similar vehicles, as well as hearses and ambulances, are not considered as passenger type vehicles and the wage determinations would be considered applicable.
