This is in reply to your letter of October 21, 1970, concerning Title III, Restriction on Garnishment, of the Consumer Credit Protection Act.

It is not clear from your letter whether a voluntary petition in bankruptcy is involved or whether there has been a petition filed under Chapter XIII of the Bankruptcy Act. The exemption in section 303(b)(2) of the Act runs only to orders of the Bankruptcy Court under Chapter XIII. Any other order of a Bankruptcy Court would appear subject to the garnishment restrictions provided in section 303(a).
