This is to inform you that we propose to revoke your Certificate of Registration No. 6-48-3455-75-R-TA-HU. Our decision is based upon Sections 5(b)(6) and 5(b)(10) of Public Law 93-518, the Farm Labor Contractor Registration Act, as amended.

Section 5(b) of the Act, copy enclosed, provides that, upon proper notice and hearing, the Secretary of Labor may revoke a certificate of registration for any of the reasons enumerated in that Section. Under Section 5(b)(6) revocation may be initiated when a farm labor contractor has recruited, employe', or utilized, with knowledge, the services of any person who is an alien not lawfully admitted for permanent residence or who has not been authorized by the Attorney General to accept employment. Pursuant to Section 5(b)(10), revocation is in order when a farm labor contractor has failed to comply with any provisions of the Act or any regulations issued thereunder.

Information furnished by the Federal Bureau of Investigation from fingerprints you submitted indicates that you were convicted on January 22, 1971 of illegally transporting Mexican aliens. In view of this conviction, we conclude that Sections 5(b)(6) and 5(b)(10) of the Act apply.

You have a right to request a hearing on this proposal to revoke your certificate. Such a request must be made in writing not more than 20 days after service of this notice, and should be addressed to me as follows:

If a request for a hearing is not received within the time specified, the proposed decision to revoke will become the Order of the Secretary. You should be aware that farm labor contractors required to register under the Act and who operate without certificates of registration may be subject to the penalties provided by the law.
