This is in response to your SF-98, Notice No. A 103958, calling for repairs and modifications of a marine vessel.

Based on the information provided in your SF-98, the proposed contract would be subject to the Davis-Bacon Act rather than the Service Contract Act. The Davis-Bacon Act applies to Federally financed contracts in excess of \$2,000 for the construction, alteration, and/or repair, including painting and decorating, of a public building or a public work. Marine vessels have historically been considered to be public works within the meaning of the Davis-Bacon Act.

As set forth in section 4.4(a) of Regulations, 29 CFR Part 4, SF-98s are required to be submitted at least 30 days prior to the date of solicitation. Since your SF-98 was not submitted on a timely basis and since the contract clearly appears to be subject to the Davis-Bacon Act, it is requested that your agency take all necessary steps applicable wage decision which should be obtained in accordance with Regulations, 29 CFR Part 1.
