ANDREWS' WESTERN TOUR

Plans for a "swing around the circle" for conferences with employer and employee groups in nine principal cities, including four on the Pacific Coast, were announced today by Elmer F. Andrews, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor. His itinerary:

Chicago, November 25; Minneapolis, November 26; Seattle, November 29; Portland, November 30; San Francisco, December 1-2; Los Angeles, December 2-3; Salt Lake City, December 5; Denver, December 6; Chicago, December 8 and New York, December 9.

Among the organizations to be addressed by the Administrator are the Illinois Manufacturers' Association in Chicago, the Commonwealth Club in San Francisco and the National Association of Manufacturers in New York.

"I regret that it is impossible for me to accept even a substantial portion of the invitations which have been extended me from dozens of cities," Mr. Andrews said. "This is to be a sort of inspection-and-conference trip, and my duties in Washington do not permit me to give half as much time to it as I would like. The itinerary has been chosen in an effort to cover as much territory as possible in the very limited time at my disposal."
