TEXTILE COMMITTEE MEETING DECEMBER 14-17

The Textile Industry Committee, first to be set up under the provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act by Administrator Elmer F. Andrews, will meet at 10 a.m., December 14 in room 3229, U. S. Department of Labor Building, Committee Chairman Donald Nelson announced today (Tuesday).

The committee meeting will be in session four days, according to the program announced by Mr. Nelson. Reports will be received from its subcommittees, from the Cotton-Textile Institute and other employers' representatives, and from representatives of labor.

Meanwhile, information which will assist the Committee in its deliberations is being gathered under the direction of the staff of the Wage and Hour Division of the Department of Labor.
