FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PACKING HEARING

SET FOR JANUARY 9th

A hearing on the proposed amendments to the "area of production" regulations promulgated by Administrator Elmer F. Andrews, Wage and Hour Division, U.S. Department of Labor, will be held on January 9, 1939, at 10 o'clock a.m. at the Raleigh Hotel, Twelfth Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, Washington, D. C., it was announced by Deputy Administrator Paul Sifton, today. The hearing will be held before Mr. Merle D. Vincent, Chief of the Hearings and Exemptions Section. The suggested amendments were advanced by fruit and vegetable growers and processors who would come under the regulations, and was originally set for December 14th. This is the second postponement made at the request of the petitioners and other interested parties who desired more time to collect material which they wish to present at the hearing.
