SHOE COMMITTEE MEETING POSTPONED TO MAY 25

Industry Committee No. 6 (for the shoe manufacturing and allied industries) will hold its public hearing of testimony from trade associations and labor groups at 9:30 A.M., May 25, in the ball room of the Hotel Raleigh, Washington, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Francis J. Haas, chairman of the committee, announced today.

The meeting had been originally scheduled for May 2 but was postponed at the request of trade association officials who wished to have more time to prepare their testimony.

The committee is authorized under the Fair Labor Standards Act to recommend minimum wage rates for the industry up to 40 cents an hour.
