## APPAREL INDUSTRY COMMITTEE TO MEET MAY 8

Industry Committee No. 2 (for the apparel industry) will meet in the Hall of Nations in the Washington Hotel, Washington, D. C., May 8, 1939, at 9:30 A.M., Louis E. Kirstein, Chairman, announced today.

At this meeting the Committee will hear testimony from associations that were unable to prepare their material for presentation to the Committee at the conferences held in March.

The Committee is authorized under the Fair Labor Standards Act to recommend minimum wage rates for the industry up to  $40 \not <$ an hour.
