INDUSTRY COMMITTEE REGULATIONS REVISED

A series of technical amendments to the regulations applicable to Industry Committees in the operation of the Fair Labor Standards Act, were issued today by Elmer F. Andrews, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, U.S. Department of Labor. The amendments which are published today in the Federal Register, as provided in the Act, make no basic changes in the rules governing Industry Committees, but clarify the procedure and policy to be followed in filling vacancies on committees caused by death or resignation, furnishing legal, stenographic and clerical aid to committees, insuring privacy of information, filing minority or dissenting reports, and in having committees represented at hearings before the Administrator on their recommendations.
