HEARING ON RECORD-KEEPING FOR "RED CAPS"

A hearing on possible additional records regulations concerning employment of "Red Caps", or hand-baggage porters, was scheduled today for June 27 by Administrator Elmer F. Andrews, of the Wage and Hour Division, United States Department of Labor.

The hearing will be held before Gustav Peck, Assistant Chief of the Hearings and Exemptions Section of the Division, at 939 D Street, N. W., Washington, and will begin at 10 a.m.

The question on which evidence and argument will be submitted at the hearing is:

"What, if any, amendments should be made to Part 516 of the Regulations issued by the Administrator under Section 11 (c) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, to require special or additional records to be kept by employers of Red Caps, or hand-baggage porters?"

Persons who want to be heard on the question are instructed to notify Administrator Andrews in writing on or before June 24, and indicate the amount of time desired for their presentation.
