Certificates for the employment of learners in the hosiery industry at hourly wages lower than the minimum wage applicable under Section 6 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 (Hosiery Wage Order) are issued to the employers listed below effective September 18, 1939, until September 18, 1940, subject to the terms contained in the Federal Register today, September 9, 1939.
