TEXTILE WAGE POSTERS MAILED TO MILLS

Fifteen thousand copies of a poster on the 32-1/2 cent minimum wage for the textile industry going into effect tomorrow have been mailed to textile mills, the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor, announced today. According to directions in the administrative findings approving the 32-1/2 cent wage, this poster "shall be posted and kept posted in a conspicuous place in every establishment producing textiles (as defined in the order) for interstate commerce and in every department of such establishments where employees are working. Failure to post and keep posted is a violation of the law."
