ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF INDUSTRY COMMITTEE  
NO. 2 FOR THE APPAREL INDUSTRY FROM FEBRUARY 3  
TO FEBRUARY 19, 1940

WHEREAS, previous notice was given in the Federal Register that the Administrator would receive written briefs in the matter of the recommendations of Industry Committee No. 2 for minimum wages in the Apparel Industry on or before February 3, 1940, and
