THOMAS HOLLAND TO PRESIDE AT WOOL HEARING

Thomas Holland, Chairman of the Public Contracts Board (Walsh-Healey Act), has been designated as presiding officer at the public hearing on the proposed minimum wage for the Woolen Industry beginning February 5, 1940 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 208, 939 D St., N. W., Washington, D. C., the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor, announced today.

The hearing will be on the recommendation of the Woolen Industry Committee for a 36-cent-an-hour minimum wage for the industry.
