



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 39  
DESIGNATING GEORGE E. OSBORNE  
AS VICE-CHAIRMAN OF  
INDUSTRY COMMITTEE NO. 9  
FOR THE  
RAILROAD CARRIER INDUSTRY

WHEREAS, Frank Porter Graham, Chairman of Industry Committee No. 9 for the Railroad Carrier Industry, appointed by Administrative Order No. 34, dated November 2, 1939, has reported that, due to personal illness, he will be unable to attend the meeting of Industry Committee No. 9, beginning on February 12, 1940;

NOW THEREFORE: by virtue of and pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Harold D. Jacobs, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, do hereby designate George E. Osborne, a member of such Committee, representing the public, as vice-chairman with full authority to fill such office and to act in the absence of the Chairman of the Committee.
