LEATHER INDUSTRY COMMITTEE TO MEET APRIL 8

Industry Committee No. 10 for the leather industry will meet at 9:30 A.M., April 8, 1940, in Room 208, Hutchins Building, 939 D Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., it was announced today by the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor.

This will be the first meeting of this committee, which is authorized to recommend a minimum wage up to 40 cents an hour for employees in the industry. Msgr. Francis J. Haas, Dean of the School of Social Science, Catholic University of America, is chairman of the committee.
