TEXTILE, HOSIERY AND MILLINERY COMMITTEES DISSOLVED

Three industry committees, which have completed the work of investigating their industries and recommending minimum wage rates, were dissolved today by Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor. (Federal Register, March 20, 1940.)

They are Industry Committee No. 1 for the Textile Industry, Industry Committee No. 3 for the Hosiery Industry, and Industry Committee No. 5 for the Millinery Industry. The Order of Dissolution states, "In accordance with the recommendations of these committees, the Administrator issued wage orders setting minimum wages for these industries, and the functions of these committees have now been completed."
