GLOVE LEARNER ORDER TO BE REVIEWED

An order of Merle D. Vincent, Director of the Hearings Branch, Wage and Hour Division, United States Department of Labor, relating to employment of learners in knitted fabric glove manufacture will be reviewed, Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Division, announced today. (Federal Register, March 22,1940.)

Interested parties will be allowed to submit briefs up to the close of business April 13, 1940, either in support of or in opposition to the order. All briefs must be filed in triplicate.

The order will be reviewed, Colonel Fleming said, on the application of the Underwear Institute, which, in accordance with the regulations, was filed within 15 days after publication of the order in the Federal Register (February 20,1940).
