ARTIFICIAL FLOWER LEARNER HEARING POSTPONED TO APRIL 3

Hearing on applications for permission to employ learners in the artificial flower industry at less than the minimum wage has been postponed from April 2 until April 3, it was announced today by Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division. (Federal Register, March 27, 1940.)
