NOTICE OF CHANGE IN DATE FOR FILING WRITTEN STATEMENTS OR NOTICES OF INTENTION TO APPEAR FOR HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS OF PART 541 OF REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT TO THE DEFINITION OF THE TERMS "EXECUTIVE, ADMINISTRATIVE, PROFESSIONAL ... OUTSIDE SALESMAN" AS THEY AFFECT EMPLOYEES IN THE WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTIVE TRADES

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of March, 1940, (F.R. VOL.V, Page 1096) Notice of Hearing on the Proposed Amendments of Sections 541.1, 541.2, and 541.4 of Regulations Issued Under the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, was duly issued by Philip B. Fleming, Administrator, Wage and Hour Division, United States Department of Labor, to commence on April 10, 1940 at 10 o'clock a.m. at the Washington Hotel, 15th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue, Washington, D. C., before Mr. Harold Stein, the presiding officer designated, on the following question:

What, if any, amendments should be made to Section 541.1, 541.2 and 541.4 of regulations issued under Section 13(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 defining and delimiting the terms "executive, administrative, professional, ... and ... outside salesman," with respect to the wholesale distributive trades; and

WHEREAS, it now appears appropriate to extend the date for filing written statements and notices of intention to appear at this hearing from April 3rd to April 9th;

NOW TAKE NOTICE that said date for filing written statements and notices of intention to appear has been postponed to the 9th day of April, 1940.
