
DISSOLVING INDUSTRY COMMITTEE NO. 1-A  
FOR THE WOOLEN INDUSTRY AND INDUSTRY  
COMMITTEE NO. 4 FOR THE HAT INDUSTRY

WHEREAS, the Administrator by Administrative Order No. 11 dated January 7, 1939, appointed Industry Committee No. 1-A for the Woolen Industry, which Committee has duly investigated conditions in said Industry and recommended a minimum wage rate therefor which has been approved and carried into effect by the Administrator in a Wage Order dated May 13, 1940 (Title 29, Chapter V, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 556), and the functions of said Committee have now been completed; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator by Administrative Order No. 16 dated March 7, 1939, appointed Industry Committee No. 4 for the Hat Industry, which Committee has duly investigated conditions in said Industry and recommended minimum wage rates therefor which have been approved and carried into effect by the Administrator in a Wage Order dated May 13, 1940 (Title 29, Chapter V, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 557), and the functions of said Committee have now been completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Industry Committee No. 1-A for the Woolen Industry and Industry Committee No. 4 for the Hat Industry be and they hereby are dissolved.
