



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 53

APPOINTING MERLE D. VINCENT, GUSTAV PECK, HAROLD
STEIN, PAULINE C. GILBERT AND ALEX NORDHOLM
AS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES TO GRANT OR DENY
APPLICATIONS FOR, AND TO CANCEL SPECIAL CERTI-
FICATES FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF APPRENTICES,
HANDICAPPED WORKERS AND LEARNERS.

By virtue of, and pursuant to the authority vested in
me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Philip B. Fleming,
Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, Department of Labor,
hereby designate and appoint Merle D. Vincent, Gustav Peck,
Harold Stein, Pauline C. Gilbert and Alex Nordholm as my author-
ized representatives, with full power and authority to grant or
deny applications for special certificates for the employment of
apprentices, handicapped workers and learners, and to sign, issue
and cancel special certificates authorizing the employment of
apprentices, handicapped workers and learners pursuant to the
provisions of Section 14 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938
and Regulations, Title 29 - Labor, Chapter V - Wage and Hour
Division, Parts 521, 522 and 524.
