SEASONAL EXEMPTION FOR NORTHERN BRANCH OF THE SAND AND GRAVEL INDUSTRY EXTENDED AND MADE FINAL

A seasonal exemption from the hours provision of the Fair Labor Standards Act for the northern branch of the sand and gravel industry as an industry of a seasonal nature was extended and made final today by the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor, (Federal Register, June 4, 1940.)

This extension of the seasonal exemption applies to the sand and gravel plant of the Portland Sand and Gravel Company in Northampton County, Pennsylvania, which is not included within the northern branch of the sand and gravel industry.

On April 26, 1940, a prima facie case for the granting of such an exemption was declared to exist. Since no objection or request for a hearing was raised within fifteen days from the time the exemption was proposed, a finding declaring this industry to be of a seasonal nature and, therefore, entitled to the exemption sought was made final.
