CARPET AND RUG COMMITTEE TO MEET JULY 9

Industry Committee No. 12 for the Carpet and Rug Industry will meet in executive session at 10:00 A. M., July 9, in Room 208, Hutchins Building, 939 D Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., it was announced today by the Wage and Hour Division, United States Department of Labor.

This will be the first meeting of this committee which is authorized to recommend a minimum wage up to 40 cents an hour for employees in the industry. The committee will take into consideration data prepared for it by the Research and Statistics Branch of the Wage and Hour Division and by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Arthur D. Hill of Boston, Chairman of the Committee, will preside.
