ADMINISTRATOR REVERSES DENIAL OF LEARNERS TO SALANT AND SALANT

A certificate authorizing employment of 108 additional learners was ordered issued to Salant and Salant, Inc., for plant expansion at Lawrenceburg, Tenn., by Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, in a review of the proceedings in which the company had been denied such a certificate. (Federal Register, June 11, 1940.)

"On the basis of the entire record and the briefs submitted," Colonel Fleming wrote, "I find that the denial of the aforementioned application * * * was in error and that it is necessary, in order to prevent curtailment of opportunities for employment, to issue a Special Certificate to the applicant authorizing the employment of 108 additional learners in stitching machine operations for expansion of the applicant's plant at Lawrenceburg, Tennessee."
