WOOL LEARNER HEARING AUGUST 9

A hearing on the matter of certificating learners at less than the 36-cent an hour minimum of the Wool Wage Order will be held at 10:00 a. m. Friday, August 9, 1940, at the Hotel Raleigh, Washington, D. C., Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator, Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor, announced today. Merle D. Vincent, Director of the Hearings Branch of the Division, will preside. The hearing will be limited to testimony on the occupations in the Woolen Textile Industry as defined in wage order establishing the 36-cent minimum.
