REVISED NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE
SPECIAL INDUSTRY COMMITTEE FOR PUERTO RICO
FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING EVIDENCE TO BE
CONSIDERED IN RECOMMENDING MINIMUM WAGE RATES
FOR EMPLOYEES IN PUERTO RICO ENGAGED IN THE
NEEDLEWORK INDUSTRIES

S. Department of Labor, El Banco Popular Building, San Juan, Puerto Rico and at the offices of the Wage and Hour Division of the U. S. Department of Labor in Washington, D. C.
