FRANK M. MAYFIELD NAMED TO SPECIAL INDUSTRY COMMITTEE FOR PUERTO RICO

Appointment of Frank M. Mayfield of St. Louis, Missouri, President of the National Retail Dry Goods Association, to succeed Herbert O. Bergdahl as a member of the special industry committee for Puerto Rico, was announced today by Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division of the United States Department of Labor.

Mr. Mayfield, who is President of Scruggs-Vandervoort-Barney, Inc., a department store of St. Louis, will accompany Colonel Fleming and other members of the committee to Puerto Rico where sessions of the committee will begin on September 23.

An Administrative Order appointing Mr. Mayfield to the committee was published in today's Federal Register. (September 11, 1940.)
