GLOVE LEARNER REGULATIONS EXTENDED

The findings and determination of Merle D. Vincent, Director of the Hearings Branch, Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor, relating to the employment of learners in the glove branch of the apparel industry were reaffirmed by Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator, and extended indefinitely, it was announced today. (Federal Register, September 20, 1940.)

Employers wishing to make application for the employment of learners at less than the minimum rate and present holders of learner certificates must make application on forms furnished by the Wage and Hour Division for such employment beyond October 24, 1940, the original termination date of Mr. Vincent's findings.
