ADMINISTRATOR EXTENDS LEARNER CERTIFICATES IN APPAREL,
GLOVE, TEXTILE, AND KNITTED WEAR INDUSTRIES

Extension of special learner certificates in the apparel, glove, textile, and knitted wear industries two months beyond their expiration dates was announced today by Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor.

The certificates extended are those marked valid until October 24, 1940. Certificates issued in these industries until the recent revision in learner regulations were so marked. They are extended until December 24, 1940.

The extension was found to be necessary in order to give the hearings branch of the Division an opportunity to review applications for renewal.

All holders of these certificates which were to expire October 24, 1940 who find it necessary to renew certificates should re-apply as soon as possible. Application forms will be mailed certificate holders.
