
AUTHORIZATION OF JAMES F. KING TO ACT
IN ABSENCE OF THE ADMINISTRATOR AND
THE DEPUTY ADMINISTRATOR

By virtue of and pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, Department of Labor,

Do hereby authorize James F. King, Assistant to the Administrator, to act as Administrator and to exercise any or all of the powers of the Administrator under the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 when the Administrator and the Deputy Administrator are unable to act by reason of sickness or absence from Washington.

This order shall be effective as of October 23, 1940.
