PORTABLE LAMP AND SHADE COMMITTEE TO MEET NOVEMBER 12

The first meeting of the portable lamp and shade industry committee under the Fair Labor Standards Act has been called for 10:00 A. M., November 12, 1940, in Room 4221 of the Department of Labor Building, Washington, D. C., by Max Meyer, Chairman of the Millinery Stabilization Board, who is chairman of the committee.

The committee is authorized to investigate the economic and competitive conditions in the industry and to recommend minimum wage rates. Such recommendation may be put into force by a wage order if the Administrator approves after a public hearing at which any interested person may appear.
