ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 68

DESIGNATING THE REGIONAL DIRECTORS AND THE ACTING REGIONAL DIRECTORS OF REGIONS 11 AND 12 AS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES TO GRANT OR DENY APPLICATIONS FOR SPECIAL CERTIFICATES FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF HANDICAPPED WORKERS, AND TO CANCEL SUCH SPECIAL CERTIFICATE.

By virtue of, and pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, Department of Labor, hereby designate and appoint the regional directors or the acting regional directors of regions 11 and 12 as my authorized representatives, with full power and authority to grant or deny applications for special certificates for the employment of handicapped workers, and to sign, issue and cancel special certificates authorizing the employment of handicapped workers pursuant to the provisions of section 14 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1958 and Regulations, Title 29—Labor, Chapter V — Wage and Mour Division, Part 524.
