JEWELRY COMMITTEE TO MEET NOVEMBER 25

The first meeting of the jewelry industry committee under the Fair Labor Standards Act has been called for 10:00 A.M. November 25, 1940, in Room 3229 of the Department of Labor Building, Washington, D. C., by Clyde O. Fisher, Professor of Economics at Wesleyan University, Middletown, Connecticut, who is chairman of the committee.

The committee is authorized to investigate the economic and competitive conditions in the industry and to recommend minimum wage rates. Such recommendation may be put into force by a wage order if the Administrator approves after a public hearing at which any interested person may appear.
