INACTIVE

By virtue of and pursuant to the authority vested in me by
the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Philip B. Fleming,
Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, Department of Labor,

Do hereby authorize Burton E. Oppenheim, Director of the
Industry Committee Branch, to act as Administrator and to
exercise any or all of the powers of the Administrator under the
Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, on December 6 and December 7,
1940, in the absence of the Administrator, the Deputy Administra-
tor and the Assistant to the Administrator.

This order shall be effective as of December 6, 1940.
