SAN ANTONIO PECAN FIRM ENJOINED IN WAGE-HOUR CASE

In the first court action in the drive to clean up wage-hour violations in the pecan industry in the Southwest, Federal Judge R. J. McMillan in San Antonio today permanently enjoined Azar and Solomon, San Antonio pecan firm, from continuing to violate the Wage and Hour Law.

Restitution of \$766 was ordered paid to 50 employees, according to work received here by Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor.

Under the terms of the injunction obtained as a result of an investigation made under Regional Director G. C. Street, Jr., the pecan firm is r4strained from subsequent violations. In the past the firm is alleged to have violated the wage and overtime provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act, failed to maintain proper records, and with handling "hot goods" which had been worked on in violation of the Act.
