ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 73

DESIGNATING THE TERRITORIAL REPRESENTATIVE OR THE ACTING TERRITORIAL REPRESENTATIVE OF PUERTO RICO AS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO GRANT OR DENY APPLICATIONS FOR SPECIAL CERTIFICATES FOR THE EMPLOYMENT OF HANDICAPPED WORKERS, AND TO CANCEL SUCH SPECIAL CERTIFICATE.

By virtue of, and pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, Department of Labor, hereby designate and appoint the territorial representative or the acting territorial representative of Puerto Rico as my authorized representative, with full power and authority to grant or deny applications for special certificates for the employment of handicapped workers, and to sign, issue and cancel special certificates authorizing the employment of handicapped workers pursuant to the provisions of section 14 of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 and Regulations, Title 29 -- Labor, Chapter V -- Wage and Hour Division, Part 524.
