

PUERTO RICO FOR MINIMUM WAGES IN THE FABRIC AND LEATHER
GLOVE DIVISIONS OF THE NEEDLEWORK INDUSTRIES IN PUERTO RICO

Notice is hereby given that the Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division will hear oral argument upon the complete record of the hearing on the Recommendations of the Special Industry Committee for Puerto Rico for Minimum Wages in the Fabric and Leather Glove Divisions of the Needlework Industries in Puerto Rico in Room 3229, Department of Labor Building, 14th Street and Constitution Avenue, N.W., Washington, D. C., at 10 a.m., January 22, 1941. Oral argument may be presented by any person who entered an appearance at the reopened hearing on this matter which was held on December 16, 1940, provided that on or before January 17, 1941, such person notifies the Wage and Hour Division, in writing, of his intention to offer oral argument.

Pursuant to notice given at the hearing of December 16, 1940, briefs in support of or in opposition to the aforesaid recommendations may be filed by persons who appeared at this hearing provided that such briefs are filed with the Administrator on or before January 3, 1941.
