\$10,000 WAGE RESTITUTION ORDERED IN GEORGIA LUMBER MILL WAGE-HOUR CASE

About 125 employees of the Cleveland-Oconee Lumber Company, Gardeners, Georgia, will receive more than \$10,000 in back wages due them under wage and hour provisions of the Fair Labor Standards Act as a result of court action taken by the Wage and Hour Division, U. S. Department of Labor, to enforce compliance with the act.

Federal Judge Bascom S. Deaver, in U. S. District Court at Macon, Georgia, has just signed a consent decree ordering restitution of the back wages after Wage and Hour Division attorneys had filed suit against the company alleging failure to comply with the act.
