ENAMELED UTENSIL WAGE HEARING POSTPONED

A public hearing on a minimum wage recommendation of the Industry Committee for the Enameled Utensil Industry scheduled for January 6, 1941, has been postponed until January 27, 1941, in Washington, Colonel Philip B.
