ORAL ARGUMENT ON MINIMUM WAGE RECOMMENDATION FOR PUERTO RICAN

GLOVE MANUFACTURE RESCHEDULED FOR JANUARY 6

Oral argument on the minimum wage recommendations for the fabric and glove manufacturing industry of Puerto Rico, scheduled for January 22, 1941, has been moved forward to January 6, 1941, Colonel Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, announced today.

Participation at this hearing, which will begin at 10:00 A.M., in the Hamilton Hotel, 14th and K Streets, N.W., Washington, D.C., will be limited to those who appeared at the reopened hearing on the recommendations held on December 16, 1940. Notices of intention to appear must be filed with the Wage and Hour Division not later than January 3, 1941. Briefs in support of or in opposition to the recommendations will be received on or before the same day.
