FIFTEEN ILLINOIS COMPANIES ENJOINED FROM VIOLATING WAGE-HOUR ACT

A mass consent decree enjoining fifteen companies engaged in the warehousing and wholesale distribution of food products and other commodities at Joliet, Illinois, from further violation of the Fair Labor Standards Act has been issued by Judge William J. Campbell, in U. S. District Court at Chicago.

The court ordered thirteen of the companies to make restitution to sixty-five employees of a total of \$5,518 due as a result of failure to pay workers the minimum wage and overtime compensation required under the act.

The Division's complaint also alleged failure to maintain adequate and accurate employment records, also required by the act.

Defendants included Peter J. Lennon Company, Holmstrom-Pilcher Company, Will County Produce Company, Inc., Cash Wholesale Produce Company, Delihanty Candy Company, Fred Sehring Candy Company, Turigliatto Brothers, Miller and Singer Liquor Company, United Liquor and Beverage Inc., Illinois Wine and Liquor Company, J. C. Adler Company, Robert Hayne, Baskerville and Company, Superior Butter Company, and Stein's Fish Market.
