ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 102

AUTHORIZING FORREST H. SHUFORD, COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ISSUE ORDERS OF INVESTIGATION AND SUBPOENAS.

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, I, Philip B. Fleming, Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, United States Department of Labor, hereby authorize Forrest H. Shuford, Commissioner of the Department of Labor of North Carolina to execute and issue orders for investigation; to designate and authorize representatives to make such investigations; to execute and issue subpoens for the attendance of witnesses and the production of books, papers, and documents.

This order delegates the powers given to the Administrator to compel by subpeona or otherwise the attendance of witnesses and the production of books, papers, and documents under Sections 9 and 11(a) of the said Act.
